The fuel dock damage is still being assessed. They figure 50 percent capacity through this winter and back to full capacity by the spring of '07.

There will be 107 new slips (32-foot and 40-foot) in the south harbor basin, planning to be available next April. Services to be built in that area include more bathrooms, trash receptacles, an oil dumpster, and an accessible pump-out station.

The Army Corps of Engineers have admitted a “design deficiency” in the breakwater but haven’t the funds to correct the “deficiency.” The city is lobbying for funds to do the job. Perhaps a note or e-mail to our senators and representatives would help get some funds moving toward protecting our boats in the harbor.

The dredging survey is about finished, bringing the south breakwater land closer to being awarded to the city.
